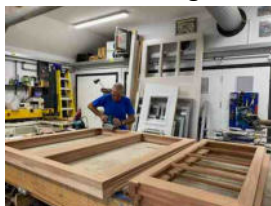

Week St Mary Bonaventures WI November Meeting

Rupert Kirkwood, The Lone Kayaker, was our speaker in November. Members and visitors were treated to fantastic photos of scenery, animals and birds, from around Devon and Cornwall intermixed with those from seven Continents.

Rupert has paddled in seven continents starting in Africa in 1989. His total distance to date is 32,000.4 miles, this equates to one and a third times around our planet.

Kayak touring, Rupert took up in earnest 10 years ago when he retired as a Farm Vet from a well-known practice in Holsworthy. Over this time, he has pieced together the entire South West coast from Poole to Minehead, Kayaking a distance of 1,154 miles. This is further than the coastal path as there were many creeks to explore.

In calm conditions in a kayak, it is the best place to view the wildlife and we were certainly treated to many wonderful photos. Having paddled on day trips to Lundy Island from Hartland and a trip to the Isles of Scilly, the vulnerability of the tiny Kayak in shipping lanes was also illustrated in the photos.

Living near the coast we all understand that a calm condition is fairly rare in Cornwall but a recent photo Rupert showed was of a Blue Finn Tuna just off the Fowey estuary, also Peregrine Falcons which have returned to our coasts, although these birds dislike human contact and numbers have dropped probably due to coastal activities like paddle boarding.

The list of wildlife we saw included Basking Sharks, Dolphins, Sun Fish, Seals, and Humpback Whales, each came with a story about how the photo was captured.

Week St Mary Advent Journey 2023

Week St Mary church will celebrate Advent with our 'Journey' as usual this year

Our 'Journey' is an adaptation of the Mexican Posada (Spanish for 'inns') where children dress up as characters from the Nativity for 9 evenings in Advent starting on December 16th. They go from house to house begging for shelter and each evening only the third house they call at lets them in. Then there is a great party where the centre piece is the breaking open of the 'piñatas' which are clay containers filled with treats of all kinds. For the adults there is a strong hot punch similar to our mulled wine with a bit more bite! On the last day the group are given shelter in the church and this is when the Christmas Midnight Mass takes place, followed by a traditional family meal when anyone without family is welcomed at other families' homes.

We will all have the opportunity to share the Journey of Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem by offering shelter in our homes to the church's Crib Figures for one night during Advent. The Journey will start at the Family Service on Advent Sunday Dec 3rd when one family will take Mary and Joseph and the donkey home and display them in a window with a lighted candle, another will take the Shepherds and yet another will take the Three Kings. The next evening, they will be taken to another house where they will spend the night and so on throughout Advent until they all arrive at the Crib Service on Christmas Eve. If you would like to offer shelter to Mary and Joseph, the Shepherds or the Kings and light a candle beside them for one evening please telephone Micheline Smith on 01288-341689 so that your chosen date can be added to the list. (Those who have taken part in the past will be offered the chance to join in again but please get in touch whether or not you are a regular churchgoer or if you have a different religious tradition, all are welcome to join in the Journey! Anyone who would like to, may join us at the start of the Journey on Sunday 3rd December at the 10am Family Service where Advent Candles will be distributed to everyone who wishes to take part. Don't worry if you can't make it to that service - you are still welcome to join in!

We encourage people to say this prayer as they hand over the figures to their new host each evening:

'As you welcome his family into your home this Advent may you welcome Jesus into your life this Christmas. Light a candle to welcome the stranger - hold it, carry it and watch for the light'

Or:

'As you welcome the shepherds into your home tonight, may you welcome Jesus into your life this Christmas. Light a candle to welcome the strangers, to show them the way as they search for the light.'

Or:

'As you welcome the Kings into your home tonight, may you welcome Jesus into your life this Christmas. Light a candle to welcome the strangers, to show them the way as they search for the light.'

You will be provided with a notice to hang outside your house if you can and it has become a tradition for people to see if they can find the figures in the windows during their evening walks, so please make sure they are visible if possible!

Poppy Appeal 2023

For the first time in thirty years' I was unable to complete our House to House Collection. 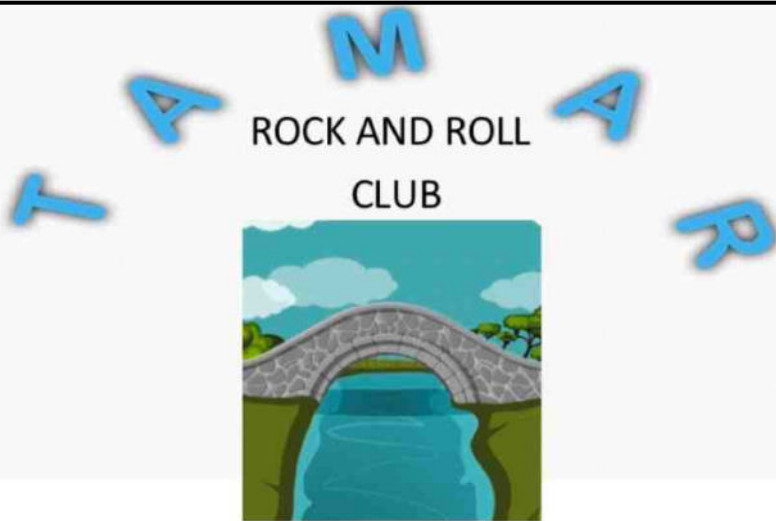

Margaret Ashley of Merry Acres passed away on Tuesday 14th November after a long illness.

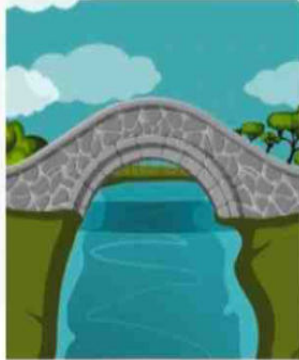
Margaret was a true character in the village and although she has been housebound for some time, will have been a familiar face to many long time residents.

Scammers don't care, they will take everything from you!

The National Fraud Intelligence Bureau (NFIB) at the City of London Police and Action-Fraud have reported they are receiving in excess of 850,000 reports of fraudulent scams each year and there are an equal number if not more that go unreported, and with AI it is getting worse!!!

A new one, or should I say an old one with a new twist is jobs working from home. Adverts in social media want people with selected skills to apply for a job, where the individual can earn up to £30,000 plus bonuses a year. There is no upfront investment and all documentation is original and correct, the applicant is tasked with some jobs, which are easily complied with and a bonus structure is commenced.

Here's the rub! The applicant now has to provide their bank and personal details to get payment. Guess what? Correct! no payment only withdrawals.

One such victim lost £18,000.

Some might say they would never get caught out as they are too careful, but a professional con man or woman can work you until you believe anything they tell you.

AN AIRBNB host has warned of being scammed out of £2,000.



Individuals are renting accommodation through Airbnb and making spurious comments and complaints regarding the accommodation and either failing to pay or demanding a refund. Basically, this is blackmail as the renter threatens to make unjustified and derogatory comments on respective social media platforms, the bad publicity is more damaging than giving a refund! Report any such occurrences to the Police.

LASTPASS users warned about a phishing email

This scam asks LastPass users to update their password or account details through a link to a fake login page. These emails are very convincing and use the same logos and branding as the real LastPass emails and are produced to a very high standard and one can be easily fooled!

In all cases don't become hurried and check the website where the email is being sent from. Have a competent email security software in place and do not respond to a SMS or email requesting your personal data.
