Dear Friends,

A short message to thank you all for your support, enquiries and prayers over the last six months, as Rob, Rebecca, Sarah and I have navigated the very difficult waters following our devastating car accident in August. The strength that we all drew from your prayers and support was immense - not just in the early days when I was so badly injured and the family were so afraid for my well being - but through every stage of my recovery process. This has been true not only for Rob and I, but for our girls who felt hugely held and reassured by the compassion, care and concern showed to us all.
