

The list of Governmental controlled activities are finite;

however, the list of unsupervised or uncontrolled privacy intrusions and data harvesting is infinite.



Yet not many people are not aware, or seem to care, on how personal information is harvested and sold, or who it is sold to and, for what nefarious purpose their personal data is used – let alone the possibility of being scammed out of personal savings etc.

Now I am not an advocate of ID cards as they will do nothing to stop immigration or illegal workers, as the current NI numbers if used correctly would do that. What concerns me more is the lack of government control on harvesting data, especially of the under aged!

Smart kids can easily access pornography or for that matter become involved in chat sites, which they should not be accessing. But the lack of controls can allow them to do so, even as they walk to school, or play in the street! Mobile phones work quite well without a sim card and an old phone connected to an internet signal becomes invisible to many parents! The issue is, service providers don't need to do it, but your data is a valuable commodity worth a considerable amount of money, all at your eventual cost!

The clerk will report this, and one towards Goscott Corner as well.

Cllr Couch asked for this to be removed as a portfolio report.

- **Social media / communications**

Cllr Couch said this was going well with new followers on the council's Facebook Page.

Councillors approved the minutes of the Ordinary meeting held on Thursday, December 4, 2025.
5. **Public question time** (15 minutes allowed for this – on matters on the agenda only)
Paddy Fay, on behalf of the football club, asked if the club could put a shipping container next to the existing shed for storage. He said the top pitch is having drainage issues and he asked if the club, at its own expense, could aerate it. This will be discussed under playgrounds later in the agenda.
6. **To receive County Councillor Nicky Chopak's report on matters arising**
Cllr Chopak said the Cornwall Council budget is out for consultation, people can have a look at it online. The council is trying to think of ways to save money. Some extra money has been allocated to Adult Social Care and Highways. February 16 is the closing date for consultations. 
