

# EE to stop 3G network in 2024

I have mentioned this before, but it is worth reminding some users of older smart phones, or possibly not so smart phones! EE, now part of BT will close down the 3G network server in the new year and it will affect; Apple iPhone 4, iPhone 4S, Samsung Galaxy Ace and Galaxy S3 Mini, Doro 6520, 6521 and 6620, Nokia 30, Nokia C2-01, TCL Pixi 4 and many other lesser-known brands.

These phones will still be able to connect to the internet and Wi-Fi talking may still be available on some systems, otherwise it will mean upgrading to a 4G phone

## Ad blockers will be banned for YouTube users

YouTube plans to restrict viewers who have ad blockers installed in their browsers to 3 video viewing unless the premium service is purchased. To avoid having a blank screen when attempting to watch videos users will be forced to disable ad blocker activity on the websites. Ad free viewing will cost £11.99 per month, otherwise you can expect to see ads every 5 to 8 minutes. YouTube explained,

the money generated from these ads is used to pay for the platform, including fees for the creators of videos as well as revenue for Alphabet, its parent company.

You can visit the metaverse for less than a £1 subscription thanks to 'Netflix for VR'.

# How to bypass Windows 11 TPM check with MediaCreationTool.bat

From this October, Microsoft will stop supporting Windows 10, patches and updates will no longer be downloaded, some would say "Thank Goodness" but it means the end is insight for Windows 10. The issue here is that systems built before 2017, Windows 11 will not be installed on it, the installer looks for a TPM V2 chip, which is not available on older computers. This means you'll need to buy a new system.... But, installing the MediaCreationTool.bat tool lets you bypass the TPM and other hardware requirements to install Windows 11, direct from Microsoft, on to your old machine.

Full instructions can be followed to make the upgrade easy and according to its programmers, if the install fails windows 10 will be reinstalled without loss of data!

But backup data first and users who continue to use Windows 10 should ensure their anti-virus is working correctly as Windows 10 will be increasingly vulnerable!

# Week St Mary Bonaventures WI

Herbal Medicines: Back to Our Roots Katrina Werren Medical Herbalist

In September, Week St Mary Bonaventures WI welcomed Katrina Werren to our monthly meeting. Katrina is a university qualified, medical herbalist who runs The Green Physic, which is a herbal medicine clinic based on her family farm in North Cornwall. At her clinic she can provide an orthodox medical diagnosis of conditions that are affecting a client's health and she provides treatments which are solely made from natural plants and herbs.

Plant based medicines have been used for hundreds of years and today many of our medicines are made from concentrated chemicals taken from the plant kingdom. Nowadays, we have largely lost the knowledge that our ancestors relied on for the relief of common ailments. However, although many people do find medicinal plants helpful, their use today is still controversial because there has been limited scientific research to prove their efficacy. Just like modern day medicine they can have side effects which is why it is wise to consult someone like Katrina who has spent years studying the subject.

Katrina grows and produces most of the medicines she uses from her organic, on site, herb garden. She illustrated her fascinating talk by showing us common plants like stinging nettles, viburnum, hawthorn and elder and told us how they are used for a wide range of different ailments. We also got to taste some delicious food containing nettles and traditional leathers made from hawthorn berries and we were able to try a warming herbal infusion of elder berries, blackberries and spices.

Members found her talk very interesting and wanted to know more about it, perhaps in further sessions in the future.

Our next meeting will be Thursday October 12<sup>th</sup> and we will be entertained by the WREN Trust. The Wren Trust was formed in 1983 and offices are at Okehampton. It is from this base that a team of skilled people have used folk arts to empower people from
