

ACORNS PRE-SCHOOL

It is with great sadness that we announce that Acorns Pre-School will be closing at the end of the summer term. Acorns has been running since 2001 and has enjoyed many years of success. However, there are a number of developments over the last few months which have led to this heart breaking decision; including the energy crisis, the national shortfall in government funding, pupil numbers and staffing . Unfortunately, these factors have led the committee to believe that continuing to run the preschool will not be financially viable.

To ensure the children of the Whitstone and surrounding villages may continue to receive childcare provision, the committee are in the process of signing the pre-school building over to Whitstone Community Primary School. The school's aim is to provide a EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage) unit which will be based in the Acorns building. This will provide care for three and four year olds as well as the reception children. Places should be available from September 2023. You are welcome to apply for a place for your child by contacting the school, you can find contact details and other information regarding this on their website.

Unfortunately, the school cannot offer places for two year olds at this time, but if you are interested in a place for your two year old, please contact the school to show your interest, as they may change this in the future. Please direct any questions you have regarding this to the school. They are happy to help with any queries you may have.

We are very pleased to officially announce that our recent OFSTED report was Good. We would like to thank our staff for their hard work and dedication towards this and the wonderful work they do every day with the children.

Acorns would like to thank everyone who has supported them throughout the years. A huge thank you to the amazing staff members past and present who have gone above and beyond to ensure the children have had the best childcare possible. The truly wonderful volunteer committee members past and present, who have given huge amounts of time, energy and enthusiasm in supporting the pre-school in both the logistics of the daily running and also the fantastic fundraising efforts. In addition, a big thank you to the families, communities and local businesses for your continued support for all our fundraising events. We are planning on holding a small get together to celebrate Acorns' success and say a fond farewell on Tuesday 18th July at Whitstone Village Hall from 9.30 to 11.30 am, all present and past family members are welcome.

Computer issues that can affect you now!

Recent Windows updates have caused some problems with some systems, I say this in this vaguest of terms as there is no consistency in these errors, only that the 'Blue Screen of Death' is displayed as each system tries to recover. If this happens to you, make a note of the error code displayed on the screen and let me know what it is. It could be a conflict with an application or invading virus, or 'adware'. I may be able to help resolve it before you run a reset

You may also need to run the recovery program and take the system back to a previous image, but don't be confused with a system reset. A system reset will reinstall windows, but also wipe out all 3rd party programs, which you would be forced to reinstall once the reset has completed.

WhatsApp has issued several warnings of late and these should not be ignored as hackers are sending out requests to access your phone using a 6-digit code. If you allow them access to your phone, the thieves will not only block you out of your own account, they will systematically attack all your contacts, steal yours and their data, then try to rob whatever they can from both you and them!



A few weeks ago, Google declared they had been hacked and over 50 million customer accounts had been stolen or compromised. Those using Google Pay should have been notified with details of what has happened. If you are a Google Pay user and have not changed your password recently, change them now!

Have you thought how easy it is to record your voice?

Voice chat is very much a thing of our time and people use TikTok, YouTube, Facebook and other platforms to tell the world about themselves, their products or their ideas, and that's great! But consider this. How easy is it for a thief to clone your voice!

Microsoft has created an AI tool called VALL-E. It can clone a person's voice in a few seconds and then generate audio in a wide range of different languages. A short audio clip of your, or a family member's voice can be stolen from any media platform and scammers can impersonate them.... and that's truly scary!!
