
New members are always welcome from 4 years to upper primary school age. We meet every Tuesday at the church and often go



You may have wondered why beautiful smells were emanating from the Chapel School Room on VE day. It was the WI! Actually, not just the members themselves but they were busy making candles under the instruction of the founder of the Clovelly Soap/Candle Company. The two perfumes that we were using were lavender/lemon grass and orange/rosemary and we proudly went home carrying our jam jar candles.



The talk and instruction was given by Sarah Harper who used to work in the City of London. In 2004, after becoming sensitive to chemicals in everyday life, she cleared out all cleaning and body-care products that she had bought and taught herself to make her own simple effective cleaning products, creams and bath products. Using her aromatherapy skills, she blended her first 8 natural soaps and started a little business in London. Following their dreams the family moved to Clovelly in 2011 and took on the name of The Clovelly Soap Company. Her husband became full-time chief soap maker in 2013 and they opened the little Soap Shop at the top of Clovelly's famous cobbled street in 2014. Since then the business has expanded to include a hardworking crew of staff — some from Clovelly





1. Public question time (15 minutes allowed for this – on matters on the agenda only) Paddy Fay, on behalf of the football club, queried the fourth amendment on the football club revisions. It was decided to highlight this with the solicitor to see if the council needed this to be kept in.

A resident queried the minutes of the last council meeting (not on the agenda). She said the initial impression was that a portion of the blame lay with the South Western Ambulance Trust, but they should reflect that the parish council did not tell them the old defibrillator was taken down when the new one was put into place.

2. To note councillors present

Cllrs C Slade (chair); I Richardon (vice chair); R Bolt; M Johns; S May; L Stephens and R Shipton. Also in attendance: S Cleave, clerk and seven members of the public.

- 3. To receive apologies for absence with reasons Cllr Gubbin, work; Cllr Chopak.

5. Agenda items

1. Football club lease

Cllr Slade said she was eager to get the lease sorted. Following correspondence from the solicitor and Mr Smith (whose son looked at the situation), if the council went down the route of handing it over to a solicitor, it would be prepared to split the cost 50/50, with the option of the football club paying in instalments if preferred. The clerk would forward the exact costs to Paddy and he said he would take it back to the football club, then get back to the council.

It was proposed to go down the legal route, with a letter being sent to the football club with details of the costings, and the parish council would be willing to pay half.

2. Defibrillator

The council considered handing over the contract to maintain the two defibrillators to Duchy Defibrillators at a cost of £205 plus VAT per year per unit. It was noted that the funds could be applied for from the Community Benefit Fund as it is a benefit to the community. This was proposed.

3. Audit

It was proposed to instruct Linda Coles to act as this year's internal auditor.

4. Emergency item – grass cutting

Councillors were informed that due to ill health Trevor would be unable to cut the grass and carry out the strimming etc with immediate notice. Cllr Slade said the clerk could ask Harley Friend, who does Back Lane, if he is able to cover for the time being. The clerk will send a letter to Trevor wishing him well and thanking him for all the hours he has put in for the parish over the years.

5. Date of next meeting May 20th at 19.30

6. Items for May 20, 2025 annual meeting

Smart phones are now a thief's best friend

People of all ages now use a smart phone for communication and entertainment, but they may not realise the apps they download can also create open doors to a thief who can ransack their files and steal their most private and personal data.

The term App has crept into the English language meaning small computer application and has several benefits, first to the user as a means of entertainment and second to the producer as a source of income, either legitimate or criminal.

Dangerous apps disguised as "legitimate" downloads.

Hackers have produced a range of bank-emptying tools, which silently steal your money and personal data. Attackers target Android phone users, tricking them into



installing fake downloads, Apple systems are not immune to this type of attack, but less so!

The hackers are using a development tool called .NET MAUI to create fake apps they look and feel like the real thing, these apps might claim to be for banking or dating or access to social media. This tool will mask the code hidden from antivirus software; however, these apps are not available through Google store and are blocked by Googles play protect.

This means if you receive an email or message suggesting you download an app outside of googles

protection, there's a good possibility your phone will become infected. These apps are blocked from Googles Play Store.

HOW TO CHECK YOUR APPS ARE SAFE

First, make sure that Google Play Protect is switched on in your phone. Go to Google Play Store on your Android phone and tap on your profile icon. Then go to Play Protect > Settings > Scan Apps with Play Protect and toggle the feature on.



This will scan apps you're downloading to make sure they're OK!

This technique will also work on historical downloads downloaded from unknown sources.

Turning on the "Improve harmful app detection" setting, you allow Google Play Protect to automatically send unknown apps to Google for checking.

Go to the Google Play Store, then Profile > Play Protect > Settings.
