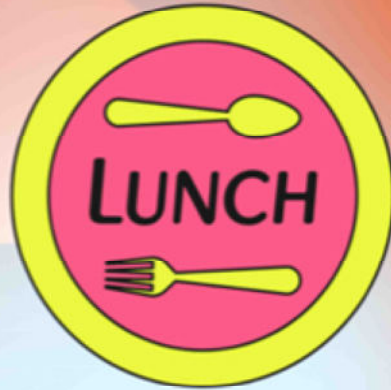

Beauty & the Beast

In April the WI met to hear from Melanie O'Reilly the owner of the Blush Beauty Salon in Bude. During the Beauty part of her talk she gave us lots of lighthearted and informative answers to our beauty questions, which covered many topics from skin care and make up, to eyebrows (tattooed or otherwise), and the pros and cons of botox.

The Beast of the title refers to Cancer in all its many forms and the treatments which can be physically and mentally very difficult, both short and long term. Melanie has been particularly keen to work with a charity called **Look Better Feel Better** for cancer patients and she now runs free beauty workshops for people with or recovering from cancer at her Blush salon.

Melanie is clearly a force of nature not only does she run a business but she is also one of the founding volunteer organisers behind new, much needed efforts to support cancer patients in the local area.

Melanie was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2021 and following a series of operations and treatments, she and a small group of other volunteers in Bude began to look at what local support cancer sufferers and their supporters needed. We all know we are a very long way from the nearest hospitals and the additional support services they offer to patients are often not practical given the distance involved. As a result of consultation with local cancer patients the **Bude Cancer Support Group** was set up with some initial funding from McMillan Cancer Support.

The **Bude Cancer Support Group** became a registered charity just this month and is now organising fund raising events. They run cancer support cafes in Bude, on a Monday afternoon, twice a month and there is an evening cafe as well. These meetings allow people to meet and talk over tea, coffee and cake and have become so popular that the venue has had to move several times to accommodate growing numbers. Over the past year they have also run regular wellness workshops and events, such as yoga, dance, art therapy, flower and plants and food for health. All of these workshops are free to male and female participants and allow people to mix with others with similar experiences which can help alleviate feelings of fear and isolation.

McMillan Cancer Support is now helping **Bude Cancer Support** look for new premises in the Bude area which can be used, 7 days a week, to build on the support that has been started.

Gmail and Outlook users urged to delete these emails

In times of financial difficulties cyber criminals become increasingly active and will use any method to get at your money, personal information or belongings. Phishing scams are the most common and will masquerade as a well-known or reputable company. These emails often have a subject line which refers to some previous contact, even if its false. Beware of the following examples

"Your delivery was unsuccessful"

"You've won a prize!"

"You contacted us first"

"Your subscription is expiring"

"You could be a millionaire"

"ALERT: Your PC may be infected!"

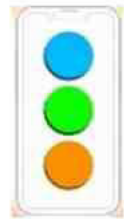
Don't open these or others with a similar subject line, just delete them, better still blacklist them!

DONT IGNORE THE DOT!

APPLE and GOOGLE now have warnings signs on your smart phone you shouldn't ignore. They can reveal when you're being spied on by rogue apps. A green dot signifies that your camera is active – but if it's orange, your microphone is in use, if a grey arrow is shown your location is being displayed.

Some Apps need to access these to work WhatsApp and Zoom are just two. But some apps use them for nefarious purposes, and you will not know which they, that is until now!

Monitoring the dots, located in the status bar on the screen, will make you aware which app is using these devices and when. If a small clear or blue arrow spears it shows a legitimate app is in use, this will also appear in the top right corner of the screen.



For Android phones, look for a small green pill icon in the top right. You'll see it appear with a small camera or microphone icon inside it.

Both can appear inside the pill icon at the same time. These signals alert you when an app is accessing your camera or microphone.

If your location is in use, you should see a small pin icon on the status bar near your battery. You can then view your apps folder (in Settings) to see which app it relates to and if preferred, delete it!
