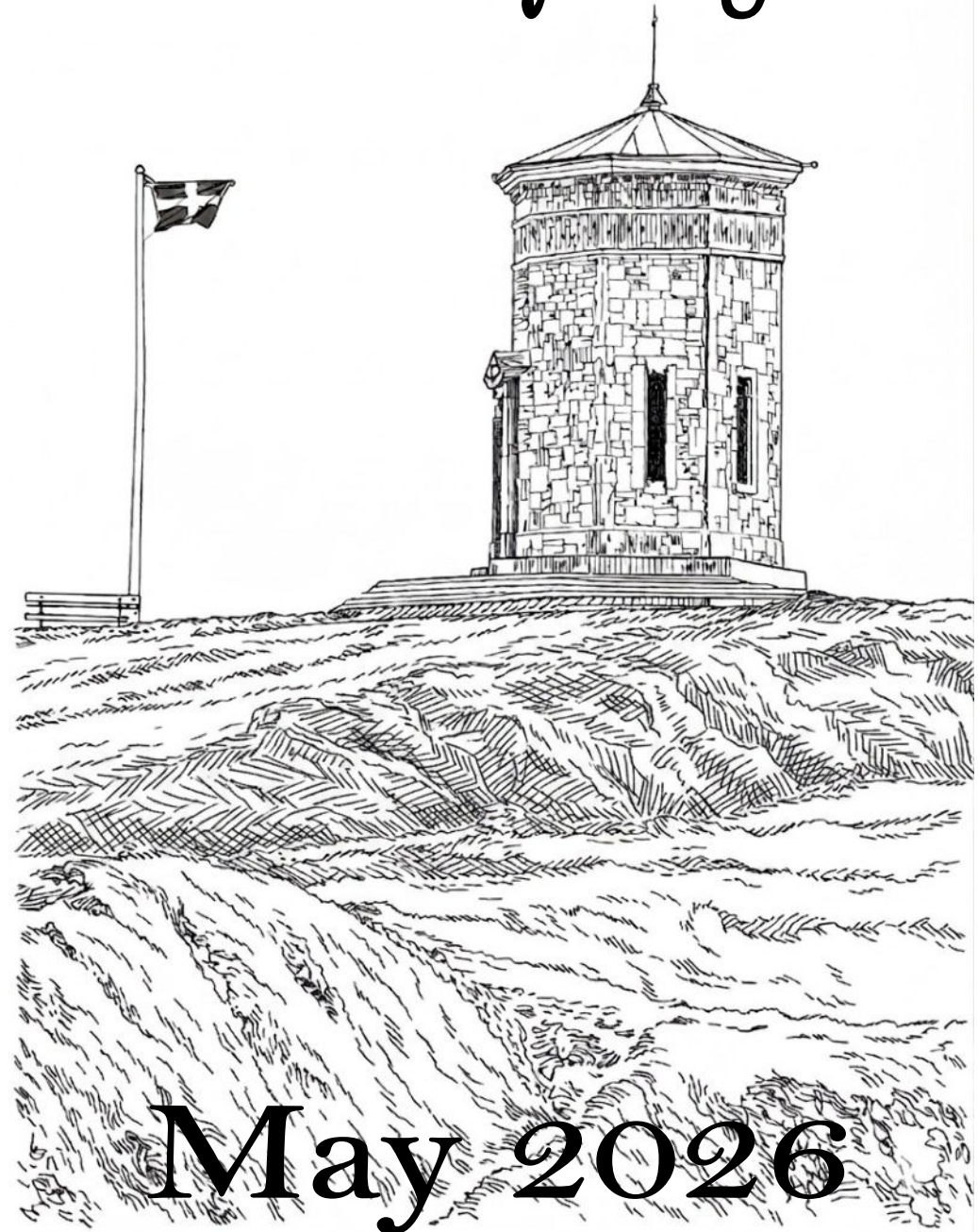

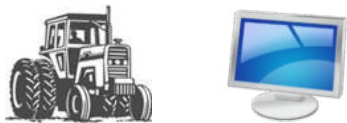

WEEK ST MARY BONAVENTURES W I

A heartfelt thank you to everyone who joined us on the evening of Thursday 26th March for the CPR/Defibrillator training session that we held at the Village Hall. The session was led by two Community First Responders, Toni and Danielle, both of whom live locally. After the introduction and demonstration everyone had the opportunity to practice CPR on the four dummies that they had brought with them – two male, one child and one baby. Hard work as we all found out but absolutely vital as a means of saving lives whilst waiting for the arrival of an ambulance.

Nearly 50 people attended from the village and our presenters were thrilled with the turnout and interest. What was even more satisfying was the amount of money collected for their charity which funds Community First Responders. They are all volunteers and have to provide their own training equipment.

Thanks were given to the Parish Council for providing the two Defibrillators in the village, one outside the Parish Hall and the second outside the Parish Office & toilets. Also the Village Hall committee wouldn't charge the WI for the hire of the Hall as it was a charity event so that money was added to the donations collected. A total of £177.50 was donated by those attending plus £60 was given from our WI, made up of our normal fee for a Speaker (they gave their services free) and the normal cost of hiring the Hall. I am assured that it will go towards the cost of acquiring a FEMALE dummy. Not before time!

We all know how intrusive Facebook is on our privacy, or do we?

Meta, owners of Facebook, Instagram and other platforms bombard account holder's computer with cookies, trackers and adverts. In the main Google Ads supply the links to different advertising contracts, they then sell the harvested data to 3rd and 4th parties, including advertising agents and other web providers for them to use.

Simple! Well, it is if you are a corporate entity who wants to profit by intruding on your privacy and bombarding you with products you may or may not want, but the algorithms installed will list you as a prospective customer and therein lies the issue. Not so simple if you are just wanting to communicate with a friend!

The data harvested includes: -

- Your Age, Gender, location, income and on and off line activity
- Active use of the platform, can reveal sleep and work schedules
- Other device information including your phone and tablet
- Payment details including transactions and Bank details
- Facial recognition via your system camera and the harvesting of other images
- Who your doctors are, your geographic details and check-in activity
- Your medical health, this compared against the content of your posts and responses
- If you have debt, payment history, credit scores and off-line financial activity
- Criminal/Police records can be checked against your name and demography
- If you are pregnant, any ante-natal or post-natal requirements can be monitored
- Your political affiliations, off-site tracking and subscription payments tracking



If you're encouraged to use Facebook for any personal or group use, be mindful of the pitfalls and ensure you have sufficient ad and tracker blockers attached to your browser. The little known and free "Librewolf" and "Brave" browsers are particularly useful.

I say all this as there has recently been an increase in computer hacking of local users' computers and it's not only the loss of money, the cost of remedial repair to a system as hackers can, and do, encrypt a system blocking access to its data or continued functions.

Antivirus software is import, but ad blockers and tracker blockers are equally necessary these days ideally installed on both your computer and mobile phone. Ask yourself, what system protection do I have? and don't say I have an Iphone so I don't need any, you are totally mistaken. Apple is as prolific in data harvesting as any other provider or platform.

Using an AI chatbot as a search engine is equally dangerous. AI models do not drop data they are programmed to retain it and as your system uses an IP address, the system knows exactly where your computer is and what you do online! There are now over 3500 AI models in existence and over 1 million sub systems each ready to harvest and use your data.

COMMUNITY MONEY ADVICE LAUNCESTON

During 2025 the Cornwall PEOPLE IN MIND outreach project has enabled Community Money Advice Launceston to visit and meet local residents of some of the most rural villages and hamlets within North East Cornwall, including Week St Mary. This has enabled our team to become engaged with some of the least advantaged locally. The elderly especially, including those who may be experiencing difficulties within their finances, particularly with their utilities, local taxes and benefit structure.

The FREE services which CMAL offer in these areas has been particularly welcome among those who find it so difficult to keep abreast with the newer methods in technology. With nationally 1 in 7 people being unable to communicate effectively with the internet/email/online banking system, it is little wonder why our team is fully stretched to help. We have a policy of helping every genuine request for help. One of the main lessons we have learnt from our visits is that many local people were unaware of us, or the areas in which we can help, and especially the direct contact we have with some agencies, like SouthWest Water or Cornwall Council about council tax problem

The major areas of immediate concern to many of our clients currently are:
