The following matters were discussed:

OPEN FORUM AT THE DISCRETION OF COUNCILLORS – There was a discussion about a solution to library books being available in Week St Mary if the Mobile Library Services ceases.

PLANNING – No Decision Notices. 1 x Application - PA13/02113 - Change of use of Little Exe Cottage from C3(a) (residential dwelling) to C2 (residential institution) to become a management centre for a proposed outdoor learning centre and change of use of grounds to outdoor learning centre for residential educational visits with associated amenity block and waste storage area. Little Exe Cottage Week St Mary. Good Energy Generation Ltd. It was agreed to deal with the application at the planned extraordinary meeting on April 17th.

CORRESPONDENCE - 13 items had been circulated.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION – Parish Publication Scheme Policy, a Policy for Handling Requests for Information and a Publication Scheme Notice were agreed and adopted.

CORNWALL ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL COUNCILS (CALC) Subscription renewal was agreed.

FINANCE - payments were approved and bank account balance noted. Receipts & Payments Balance Sheets - year ended 31.03.14, the bank reconciliation and quarterly figures had been circulated and approved.
