

## **Adventure Church Report for Annual Parish Meeting 2023**

Adventure Church continues to meet every week during Term time. We have around 20 families who take part and regularly host in excess of 14 of those families for a Bible or Moral Story, fun activities and a shared meal. During the winter the children and their parents have enjoyed a variety of craft sessions, learning about the church building, discovering the legend of St Piran, learning to cook, a village Litter pick whilst discovering our village wells, a Chinese New Year celebration and many other activities. As the weather warms up most activities will be held outside and we have plans for nature walks, visits to interesting places nearby, beach afternoons, barbecues etc

Adventure Church is open to all children of any religion or none preferably over 4 years of age (unless they have older siblings already in the group) and each family must be accompanied by an adult who is expected to help with supervision.



## Big Mix Youth Group

Week St Mary Church has been fortunate to secure the regular assistance of a volunteer qualified Youth Worker who has helped us to set up a new Youth Group for the village. The group will meet in the church when indoors as this is a convenient space with he facilities we need but it is not intended to be a solely church group, as it attempts to provide a safe meeting place for secondary age children without the necessity for travel outside of the village. The programme has been designed by the children themselves and has already included a Pizza and Movie night, a proposed Easter Egg Hunt and a variety of other activities including cooking, a fund raiser and talks from experts about subjects which interest the members.
