Adventure Church has continued throughout 2023 and into 2024 when we celebrate our tenth anniversary. We have about 25 children who attend and the average number present each week is around 18. Each family has at least one parent with them and this number averages 16. We spend the summer months outside as much as possible learning about nature and God's place at the centre of our world. In bad weather (of which there has been plenty!) or in the winter the church has remained a valuable indoor venue where we still have plenty of activity and include a lot of craft work.

Our upgraded kitchen facilities have made cooking and serving the weekly Adventure Church shared supper very much easier and we have been a little more 'adventurous' with our meals. We have also been able to do some food preparation with the children who can then cook their creations before they go home.

Activities included in the last year have included a visit from a Zoo, many different games and scavenger hunts in the churchyard, pond dipping at a local garden, creative art using natural materials, prayer stations both indoors and outdoors, dramatic re-enactments of bible stories, teamwork, needlework, science experiments, celebrating Chinese New Year, St Piran's Day and much more.
